2. <b>Anatomy</b>	The study of body structure
3. <b>arch</b>	a curved symmetrical structure spanning an opening and typically supporting the weight of a bridge, roof, or wall above it
4. <b>archives</b>	public records; place where public records are kept
5. <b>archivist</b>	a person who maintains and is in charge of archives.
6. <b>atomizer</b>	device for converting a liquid to a fine spray
7. <b>dichotomy</b>	a division into two parts
8. <b>dynamic</b>	active, energetic, forceful
9. <b>Dynamis</b>	act of power
10. <b>dynamite</b>	a powerful explosive
11. <b>dynamo</b>	generator for producing electricity; energetic person
12. <b>Dynasty</b>	A series of rulers from the same family
13. <b>gastrectomy</b>	surgical removal of part or all of the stomach
14. <b>Hematoma</b>	a solid swelling of clotted blood within the tissues.
15. <b>Hierarchy</b>	a group of persons or things arranged in order, rank, or grade
16. <b>lobotomy</b>	surgery to remove a portion of the brain
17. <b>matriarch</b>	female head of the family
18. <b>monarch</b>	king or queen
19. <b>Oligarchy</b>	A government ruled by a few powerful people
20. <b>Patriarchal</b>	relating to a society in which men hold the greatest legal and moral authority
21. <b>Psychodynamic</b>	how behavior springs from unconscious drives and conflicts
22. <b>Thermodynamics</b>	The study of energy transformations that occur in a collection of matter.
23. <b>tonsilectomy</b>	surgical removal of the tonsils

24. <b>tracheotomy/tracheostomy</b>	an incision in the windpipe made to relieve an obstruction to breathing
