

1. **aglossia:** absence of a tongue
2. **archetype:** A detail, image, or character type that occurs frequently in literature and myth and is thought to appeal in a universal way to the unconscious and to evoke a response
3. **atypical:** unlike the typical
4. **epiglottis:** A flap of tissue that seals off the windpipe and prevents food from entering.
5. **gloss:** try to conceal or disguise (something embarrassing or unfavorable) by treating it briefly or representing it misleadingly.
6. **glossary:** A place in the back of the book that gives the definitions or tell the meaning of certain words in the book.
7. **glossectomy:** removal of the tongue
8. **glottal:** vocal folds
9. **monoglot:** knowing only one language
10. **petricide:** destruction of ancient stone buildings or monuments
11. **Petrichor:** The smell of earth after rain.
12. **petrified:** so frightened as to be unable to move
13. **petroglyph:** a carving on a rock
14. **petrogram:** a drawing or painting on a rock
15. **petrography:** the description and systematic classification of rocks
16. **petroleum:** a liquid mixture of hydrocarbons that is present in certain rock strata
17. **petrous:** like a rock, hard, stony
18. **phenotype:** An organism's physical appearance, or visible traits.
19. **polyglot:** a speaker of many languages
20. **prototype:** an original model on which later versions are patterned
21. **serotype:** Representatives of a species that stimulate a distinct pattern of antibody responses
22. **stereotype:** A generalized belief about a group of people
23. **typography:** The style and appearance of printed matter.
24. **typology:** the study and interpretation of types and symbols, originally especially in the Bible.
