

1. **agamy:** Absence or nonrecognition of the marriage relation or no marriage
2. **ataxia:** lack of muscle coordination
3. **bigamist:** One who has two spouses at the same time.
4. **gamete:** specialized cell involved in sexual reproduction
5. **heterotaxic:** Abnormally placed or arranged
6. **homogamy:** marriage between people with the same social characteristics
7. **hypotaxia:** a condition of weak or imperfect coordination
8. **misogamist:** Someone who hates marriage
9. **orthodontia:** specialty of tooth straightening
10. **orthodox:** in agreement with established or generally accepted beliefs or ways of doing things
11. **orthogonal:** Having or determined by right angles; perpendicular
12. **orthographic:** the view of an object when you look at the top, front, back, left, right
13. **orthography:** the conventional spelling system of a language
14. **orthopedics:** branch of medicine dealing with the muscular and skeletal systems and their problems
15. **orthophony:** The art of correct articulation, voice training
16. **orthoptics:** Retraining of muscles that control vision.
17. **phobotaxis:** a random avoiding reaction in response to a distasteful stimulus
18. **polyandrist:** The marriage of a woman to several (more than two) men at the same time
19. **Polygamy:** having more than one spouse at a time
20. **syngamy:** Free interbreeding between organisms
21. **Syntax:** The arrangement of words and phrases to create well-formed sentences in a language.
