

1. **apocryphal:** of questionable authority or authenticity
2. **crypt:** a hidden tomb or vault
3. **cryptarch:** a secret ruler
4. **cryptic:** puzzling, mystifying, or enigmatic
5. **cryptographer:** specialist in writing and deciphering codes
6. **cryptonym:** a secret name
7. **cryptotoxic:** Having poisons whose actions are unknown/hidden
8. **encryption:** a process of encoding messages to keep them secret, so only "authorized" parties can read it.
9. **mimeograph:** a duplicating machine that uses a type of stencil to reproduce written material
10. **Mimesis:** imitation
11. **mimic:** a person who does imitations; (v.) to imitate; to make fun of
12. **mimotype:** A plant, or animal, resembling in many respects another one from which it is systematically distinct
13. **neural:** pertaining to the nerves
14. **neuralgia:** nerve pain
15. **neurasthenia:** nervous exhaustion
16. **neurologist:** A physician skilled in the diagnosis and treatment of disease of the nervous system.
17. **neuroma:** nerve tumor
18. **neuropathic:** pain as a result of damage to or dysfunction of nervous system
19. **neurotic:** suffering from a nervous disorder
20. **neurotransmitter:** chemical messengers that cross the synaptic gaps between neurons
21. **ophthamalogist:** physician who specializes in diagnosing and treating defects, injuries, and diseases of the eye
22. **optical:** pertaining to vision
23. **optician:** specialist who fills prescriptions for lenses
24. **optometrist:** a person skilled in testing for defects of vision in order to prescribe corrective glasses
